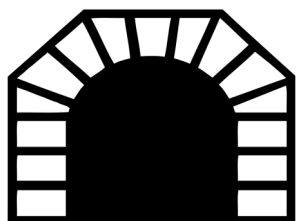

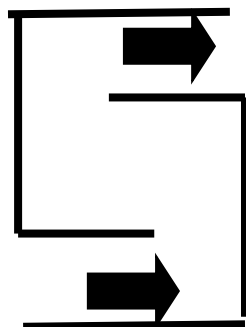

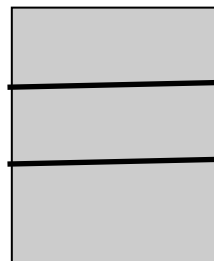

4. Tunnel. Build a very simple tunnel, NOT an arch, a tunnel is longer than an arch, at least 3ft (1m) long with sides that go right down to the ground. Lead through at walk while beside horse.



5. S-bend. Please see Handbook page 30 for construction. S bends that are too wide will lose marks. Horse walks through without touching poles or stepping out, handler must be inside S bend as well.



6. Tarpaulin poles. Place two poles on your tarpaulin that are 60cm (24in) apart. Walk into pole corridor and halt with front feet off tarpaulin beyond end of poles. **7.** Horse to backup through poles and off tarpaulin. Handler can be anywhere in 6 and 7.

8. Pick up a noisy plastic shopping bag and show it to your horse. Rub the horse's neck and shoulder with the bag while you count to five. Make sure the judges can hear the noisy bag!

9. Walk to a bucket and halt, handler picks up the bucket and carries it in the hand on the side that is not next to the horse. Horse should not push or pull to inspect bucket but lead freely to a point about 10feet (3m) away. Handler places bucket on ground under the horse's nose. **10.** Horse stands still next to handler without looking into bucket for a count of one second before they both walk on without bucket.

2. Weave in a circle. Place weave markers in a circle. Horse to weave through at walk. Handler must walk beside horse.

3. Without stopping, change direction and complete weave in the opposite direction following the same path you have just walked in Obstacle 2 in walk with handler beside horse as before.

1. The solid curtain. This is a new obstacle for some. It is just like the usual curtain but instead of ribbons you have two sheets of material which the horse has to push through. You can use your existing curtain frame by tying back the ribbons and attaching the sheets to the frame. You may have a gap between the curtains NOT MORE than 1 foot (30cm) wide. Bottom of sheets must be not more than 1feet (30cm) from the ground. Walk horse through solid curtain.
