

THE NINTH CHALLENGE



PLEASE READ THE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY AND ENSURE YOU HAVE READ THE GENERAL RULES OF THE 10 IN 20 CHALLENGE BEFORE YOU START

For this challenge you will need to build a corridor of things normally scary to horses. Flags, flapping plastic, bunting anything bright colourful and SAFE.

The scary things need to be on both sides and create a corridor that the horse can safely walk through. Make the corridor at least 15 feet (4.5m) long and as wide as is safe for your horse to travel through. In the pictures below you can see some ideas of things you can use.



All you need to do is lead your horse through the scary corridor while you go around the outside as the handler is doing in the picture below. Make sure the leadrope does not get caught on any of the scary things and make it even more scary!!
