

Platinum Liberty Trophy July 2025 10 Obstacles each out of 10

You may choose to enter at any level each month, there is no promotion system. You cannot use any equipment on your horse at this level.

THE JUDGE MUST HEAR THE REAL SOUND! DO NOT INCLUDE MUSIC OR A VOCAL COMMENTARY REMEMBER SAFETY FIRST! FOLLOW THE ARROWS

CLOSING DATE MIDNIGHT ON 31st July 2025 WHEN YOUR ENTRY IS RECEIVED SAFELY BY THE CLUB OFFICE YOU WILL BE SENT A UNIQUE ENTRY CODE. IF YOU DO NOT RECEIVE THIS CODE PLEASE CONTACT THE CLUB BY EMAIL YOUR ENTRY IS NOT VALID WITHOUT THIS CODE. REMEMBER you must keep moving forward between obstacles with no circling. If you stop or circle BETWEEN obstacles you will lose a mark from the next obstacle's score.



5 and 6. Create a weave using 5 cones or other markers. Horse and handler to weave through cones at trot **with handler at horse's right shoulder** until they reach the middle, marked with an star shape. Halt for 3 seconds then continue weaving at **canter**. Ensure the halt is BETWEEN the cones and not before or after it. **FOLLOW THE RED LINE!**

This month's course is built in a special way. Obstacles are built together in pairs PLUS there is a time limit on completing the course. If you go over the time you will lose one point for every full ten seconds over. **The time limit on the Advanced Two Star Level course is 2 minutes.**

3 and 4. Build an scary corner with scary things on both sides. The corner should be a right angle (90 degree bend). Horse to walk **QUICKLY** into the scary corner and at the corner go into a **SLOW** walk and leave the corridor as slowly as possible. Handler is directly behind horse. Make sure we can see clearly.

7 and 8. Place a raised pole across the curtain base. Horse to **jump** through curtain over pole. Handler can be anywhere.

1 and 2. Place a small mat approx. 1m x 1m (3ft 3in x 3ft 3in) NEXT to a tarpaulin with no gap between them. Horse trots onto mat and halts with his hind feet on it (fronts may go over first) while handler continues over tarpaulin **WITHOUT A HALT**. Handler waits at X for a count of three before asking horse to continue over tarpaulin at trot.

9 and 10. Place a pole on the ground at the end of a pole corridor. The width of pole corridor is 1m/3ft. Horse to trot through corridor and halt with his all four feet over the end pole for a count of three. He then backs up over the pole. He then trots on over the pole to finish. Horse must not touch pole at any time, handler can be anywhere.
