



YELLOW LEVEL EQUAGILITY July 2025

This is a two phase class, there are only five obstacles to negotiate. First you must complete the five obstacles on the ground with a halter and leadrope, a rope round the neck OR at liberty then you mount the horse and ride through the obstacles at the same pace as on the ground. For the ridden section you can use any of the following two reins attached to a halter, one rein which can change sides, rope around the neck For safety bridles and saddles are allowed (with or without trees), you may use a bareback pad (no stirrups) or saddle blanket and surcingle or ride bareback. If you use the bridle rein you will lose marks. You may have a neck strap or neck rope on the horse for safety.

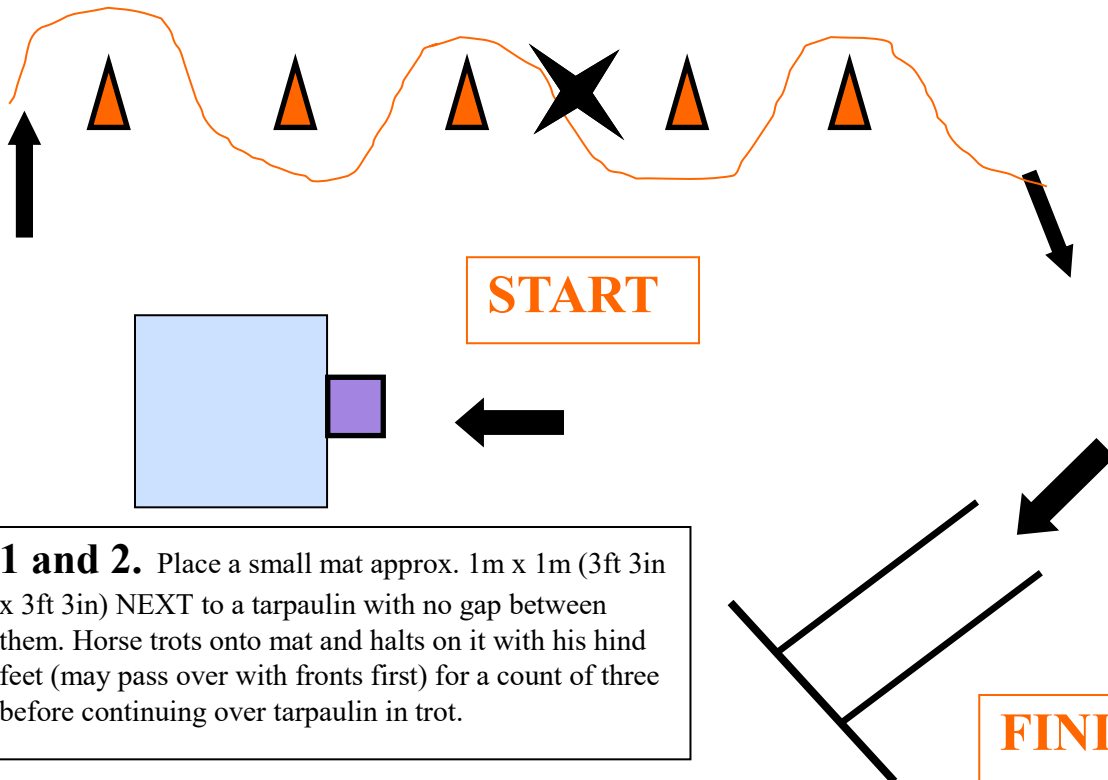
The filming must be continuous without a break between the groundwork and the ridden part so put any saddle onto your horse before you start. You may wish to put the bridle on between the groundwork and the ridden work. **THINK SAFETY AT ALL TIMES. DO NOT TAKE CHANCES** you will not be judged on your riding style but your ability to be with your horse as he carries you around the course.

Closing date for entries is 31st July 2025 WHEN YOUR ENTRY IS RECEIVED BY THE CLUB OFFICE YOU WILL BE SENT A UNIQUE ENTRY CODE. IF YOU DO NOT RECEIVE THIS CODE PLEASE CONTACT THE CLUB BY EMAIL - YOUR ENTRY IS NOT VALID WITHOUT THIS CODE. REMEMBER you must keep your lead rope/rein,/neckrope loose and keep moving forward between obstacles with no circling. If you do have a tight lead rope or stop or circle BETWEEN obstacles you will lose a mark from the next obstacle's score.

Groundwork: using lead rein, neck rein or liberty.

Ridden: two reins attached to a halter, one rein which can change sides, rope around the neck THIS COURSE IS THE SAME AS VIOLET WHERE ONLY A NECKROPE IS ALLOWED.

3 and 4. Create a weave using 5 cones or other markers. Horse and handler to weave through cones **maintaining chosen leading position while on the ground at trot** until they reach the middle, marked with a star shape here. Halt for three seconds then continue weaving at **canter**. Ensure the halt is BETWEEN the cones and not before or after it. **FOLLOW THE RED LINE!**



1 and 2. Place a small mat approx. 1m x 1m (3ft 3in x 3ft 3in) NEXT to a tarpaulin with no gap between them. Horse trots onto mat and halts on it with his hind feet (may pass over with fronts first) for a count of three before continuing over tarpaulin in trot.

5. Place a pole on the ground at the end of a pole corridor. The width of pole corridor is 1m/3ft. Horse to trot through corridor and halt with front feet over end pole, halt for a count of three then back the horse up over the pole and continue in backup until all four feet are out of the pole corridor, then walk on through corridor and over end pole. Horse must not touch poles at any time, handler can be anywhere on the ground.
