



Class H One Hit Wonder—Open to All

This is a course for anyone who hasn't any time to lay out ten different obstacles! Here you need only one pole. It can be a round pole or half round and be supported to stop it rolling, please see the photograph below. There are ten different things to do at this pole filming must be continuous and can be completed on a lead line or at liberty. **At no time must the horse or the handler touch the pole.**

1. Horse to walk over the pole without touching it.
2. Horse to walk over pole with front feet and halt for a count of three before walking on.
3. Walk front feet of horse over pole, halt then back horse up over pole, any method.
4. Horse to walk over pole as shown in the diagram at the bottom of the page. All 4 feet need to pass over the pole as the horse goes over each time.
5. Ask the horse to put one foot over pole, halt for a count of three then backup to remove foot.
6. Ask the horse to put the OTHER foot over pole, halt for a count of three then backup to remove foot.
7. Turn horse before pole and back him over pole.
8. Handler directs horse over pole, turns him and directs him to go over the pole in the opposite direction. Handler stands still throughout at end of pole.
9. Horse to walk front feet over pole and halt. Take one side step to the right then one sidestep to the left then walk on. (both front and back feet must move here).
10. Halt horse at end of pole (without walking over first) and sidepass him along pole with the pole underneath his belly, front feet on one side, hind feet on the other.
