



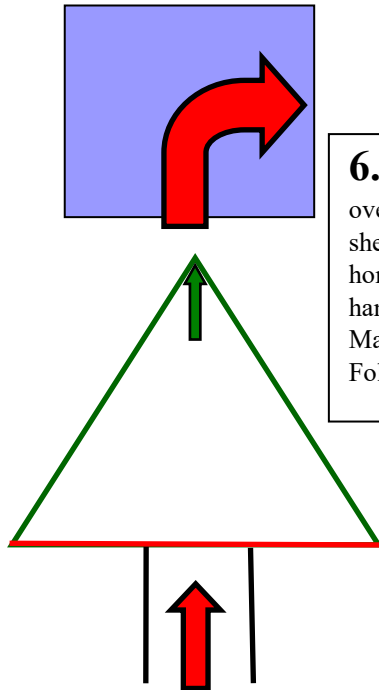
**WALKING ONLY Class WO9 (ponies) and WO10 (horses) and WO9d (donkeys, mules)**

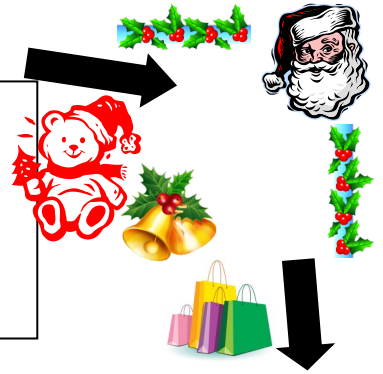

REMEMBER you must keep your lead rope loose and keep moving forward between obstacles with no circling. If you do have a tight lead rope, stop or circle BETWEEN obstacles you will lose a mark from the next obstacle's score.**

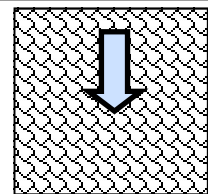


**6. Icy Pond.** Walk over a tarpaulin or white sheet safely with your horse. Handler has one hand on horse's left hip. Make sure we can see. Follow the arrow.

**7. Santa's Grotto.** Create a Christmas grotto wide enough to lead your horse through safely at walk. Handler follows directly behind horse. Have fun...it's Christmas!

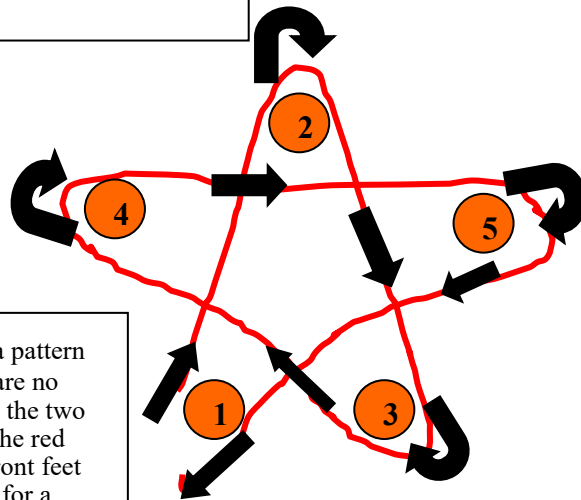


**8. Ice Flow.** FILL a square of poles with plastic bottles or scrunched up balls of paper or similar with NO gaps. You will lose marks if we can see the floor. Walk your horse through the square, handler is at horse's right hip but does not step into the square.



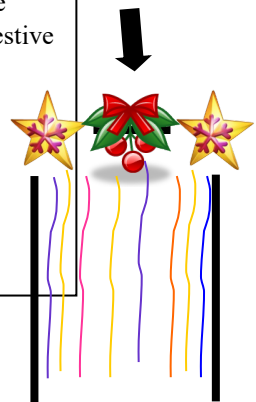
**4. Christmas Tree Trunk.** Create a pattern out of poles as per the diagram. There are no gaps between poles. Horse to walk into the two poles that make the "trunk" following the red arrow and halt over the red pole with front feet (pole will be under horse's belly). Halt for a count of five and then back horse up over pole, then walk on over pole. Handler must keep feet still during the wait and the backup.

**5. Christmas Tree Top.** Horse to walk over the corner of the top poles following the green arrow. They must walk DIRECTLY over the corner here. Handler does not need to walk over corner but leads at horse's hip. Horse must not touch poles in 4 or 5.



**3. Festive Star** Create a star pattern with five cones at the centre of your course. Follow directly behind your horse around the cones. FOLLOW THE ARROWS AND RED LINE ON PICTURE.

**9. Tinsel Cascade.** Turn your curtain into a Christmas masterpiece using tinsel or other festive hangings to create a curtain. Horse to turn before curtain and back through it while handler stands still. Handler then walks through.



**2. Santa Sack.** Pre-fill a sack or pillow case with paper or hay/straw. Show the sack to the horse then carry it resting on his back while you lead him for 10feet (3m).



**1. Santa Hat.** Put a suitably festive hat on yourself and wear it for the rest of the course. We must see you put this on.
